

## Access Drive - All Saints Church, East Garston

The church is very grateful to East Garston Parish Council for the award of a £500 grant under the Grants for the Community scheme towards the cost of purchase of gravel for the access drive to the church. The purpose was the prevention of visitors to the church getting muddy and to make the entrance to the church clean and welcoming. In addition to the normal Sunday services, the church is widely used by the whole community for baptisms, weddings and funerals and also at festivals such as the Harvest Festival and the upcoming Candlelit Carol, Children's Nativity and Christmas Day Communion Services.



The gravel was delivered on Thursday and Friday, 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> November after the wet leaves had been raked clear of the drive.
